

BRUNSWICK SPORTSMAN CLUB - RANGE AND SAFETY RULES

- 1) ***These facilities are for the exclusive use of Brunswick Sportsman Club Members and their Guests.***
- 2) Shooting hours are 8 AM until dusk.
- 3) All shooters are responsible to immediately correct any unsafe conditions.
- 4) No shooting at target frames. Post targets at the center of the target backers. Avoid placing targets so supports are shot.
- 5) Do not place targets on the ground or on target frames. No glass targets.
- 6) Carry in carry out. Take your trash, including shell casings.
- 7) Pattern shotgun using approved targets and holders at the **25 yard, or trap range.**
- 8) On 50 yard and 100/200/300 yard range, all targets MUST be posted on the designated backers. No targets will be posted ahead of designated backers.
- 9) No bump fire. No uncontrolled fire.
- 10) ALL shots shall be fired so that they will terminate in an approved backstop/berm.
- 11) **In an emergency, call 911.**
- 12) Members should acquaint themselves with the Club By-Laws. These are available at: www.brunswicksportsmansclub.org
- 13) It is the Member's responsibility to ensure that they and their guests are complying with all applicable Federal, State and Local laws while using Club facilities.

- 1) **ALWAYS** Keep the Gun Pointed in a Safe Direction
- 2) **ALWAYS** Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot
- 3) **ALWAYS** Keep the Gun Unloaded Until Ready to Use
- 4) Know Your Target and what is beyond. Make Sure the Down-Range Area is Unoccupied.
- 5) Be Sure the Gun is Safe to Operate
- 6) Be Thoroughly Familiar With How the Gun Operates
- 7) Use Only the Correct Ammunition For Your Gun
- 8) Wear Ear and Eye Protection as Appropriate
- 9) Never Use Alcohol or Drugs Before or During Shooting
- 10) Unattended Guns Should Not be Accessible to Unauthorized Persons
- 11) Be aware that certain types of guns and many shooting activities require additional safety procedures.
- 12) **Remember...YOU are responsible for each round fired.**

Brunswick Sportsman Club - New Member Orientation

1) Review and walk through of facilities and grounds. Review range and safety rules

- a. 3D archery range/Static archery ranges – no broad heads
- b. Trap range – Be aware of ranges on either side...muzzle control
- c. 25 Yard range – Be aware of adjacent trap range...muzzle control
- d. 50 Yard Range – Be aware of adjacent ranges...muzzle control. Only use club supplied backers. No targets on the ground!
- e. 100/200/300 Yard Range – Do not post targets near the top of backers. No targets on the ground!
- f. Air rifle only (in clubhouse) - Targets should only be placed on foam backers. Please ensure pellets hit backstop. Clean up when leaving.

2) Clubhouse and Grounds

- a. 20 mph speed limit on club road. Be respectful to neighbors
- b. Boy Scouts Lean To – available for club member use subject to availability
- c. Club boundaries – Aerial and tax maps in clubhouse. Walk through available subject to weather conditions.
- d. Hunting on Club property
 - i. Please be aware of houses on Bulson Road. Please be considerate of neighbors in general.
- e. Access to clubhouse
 - i. Heat – how to turn on and off
 - ii. Lights – Shut all off when leaving
 - iii. Water – off in winter months. Must turn well on to use. Be sure to turn off.
 - iv. Kitchen – If you use...clean up. Be sure to turn off all cooking devices when leaving. Keep kitchen door closed in winter months to prevent pipes from freezing.
- f. During winter months, club road is plowed to the clubhouse only. Proceed at your own risk beyond clubhouse.
- g. Please do not drive on grass or in areas where damage to ground is likely to occur
- h. The club grounds and ranges have security cameras, You may be video recorded while on club grounds. There is only Video recorded, No Audio is being recorded.

3) Guest Policy

- a. ALL GUESTS MUST complete and sign a liability waiver. Leave waiver in mailbox outside clubhouse.
- b. Guests of current members only. Must be accompanied by Member at all times. Limit of 3 guests per visit.
- c. Member must familiarize their guests with club policies and rules.
- d. Member is responsible for the actions of their guests

4) Meetings

- i. Business meetings – please attend. Volunteer for a committee
 1. Membership, Range, Buildings, Grounds, House, Archery, Legislative

5) Work Parties

- a. Spring/fall work parties – attendance is encouraged. Hours worked will be credited towards reduced dues.
- b. 24 hours worked – dues reduction
- c. Keep your contact information up to date with the club. Please report any changes to address, email address, telephone.
- d. Annual dues must be paid by 12/31. Failure to do so will result in your separation from the membership. You will need to re-apply.
