SHOOTING RANGE RULES

The Fundamental NRA Rules For Safe Gun Handling Are

- ► <u>Always</u> Keep the Gun Pointed in a Safe Direction
- ► <u>Always</u> Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot
- ► <u>Always</u> Keep the Gun Unloaded Until Ready to Use

When Using A Gun Always Follow These Rules

- ► Know Your Target and What is Beyond. Make Sure the Down-Range Area is Unoccupied
- **▶** Be Sure the Gun is Safe to Operate
- **▶** Be Thoroughly Familiar With How the Gun Operates
- **▶** Use Only the Correct Ammunition For Your Gun
- ► Wear Ear and Eye Protection as Appropriate
- ► Never Use Alcohol or Drugs Before or During Shooting
- ► Unattended Guns Should Not be Accessible to Unauthorized Persons

Be Aware That Certain Types of Guns and Many Shooting Activities Require Additional Safety Procedures.
